## LOCK YOUR DOORS!

Our neighborhood continues to have car burglaries due to unlocked vehicles. These thieves return to neighborhoods where they find opportunities to steal property. See the timeline below and notice that the time between incidents is getting shorter. If they are not able to find opportunities in our neighborhood, they will stop coming here.

We have video showing they are armed with guns. When you leave your vehicle doors unlocked, you are not only jeopardizing your property, you are putting everyone in the neighborhood at risk of being burglarized, robbed, or harmed. Make locking your vehicle a routine – set a timer for the evening as a reminder. Make sure all visitors lock their vehicles.

We are all in this together. In order to make our neighborhood safer, we need to be proactive about this. The local police are doing their part by patrolling our neighborhood nightly. Now we all need to do our part.

### RECENT HISTORY OF CAR BURGLARIES IN OUR SUBDIVISION

10/29/19 : 3 unlocked vehicles burglarized and guns stolen

12/24/19: 2 unlocked vehicles burglarized, 1 unlocked vehicle with keys left in it was stolen

3/30/20: 2 unlocked vehicles burglarized

4/21/20: 2 unlocked vehicles burglarized

5/7/20: 1 unlocked truck with keys left in it was stolen
